TRAFFIC CONTROLLER COURSE

Course Aim

To control traffic safely and effectively in accordance with Main Roads and the Queensland Department of Transport's procedures.

Course Elements & Learning Outcomes

Successful participants will achieve competency in the following areas:

- Approved attire for traffic controllers
- Authority to control traffic
- Speed limit for controlling traffic
- Responsibility for Traffic Controller Ahead signs
- Location of traffic control station
- Procedures for controlling traffic
- Communication with the public
- Two-way radio communications
- Controlling traffic at night
- Reporting offenders and incidents
- Removing or covering signs when not controlling traffic
- Level 1 Signage Certification

Course Requirements

- Any person wishing to undertake the course to become an accredited Traffic Controller in Queensland must be aware of the following important information:
- An applicant must have held an Australian or foreign open or provisional drivers licence for a period of 12 months continuously within the last 5 years. This does not apply if you are already a traffic controller renewing your accreditation.
- Upon successful completion of the course form F4115 must be submitted and a fee of **\$114.30** must be paid to the Qld Department of Transport in your area. This fee covers having a criminal history check completed and the Traffic Controller licence produced and distributed.

- The Department of Transport may refuse to grant accreditation if you have been convicted of a criminal offence or charged with an offence. (If you have any questions regarding what offences may fall into this category please call 132 380).
- Please be aware that the course and above stated fees are non-refundable if an applicant is refused accreditation by the Department of Transport.
- The processing of a licence by the Department of Transport can take 4-6 weeks. An individual
- may not work as a Traffic Controller until they physically possess a Traffic Controllers Licence.

Course Assessment

Simulated Traffic Control (competency based), and written questionnaire. Participants must be deemed 'competent' in both assessments.

Qualification

Successful participants will be issued with a '**Qualified Traffic Controller**' identity card by Queensland Transport (valid for 3 years) and '**Level 1 Signage Certification**'.

Delivery Mode

Face-to-face teacher-centred learning.
