



CPCCOHS1001A Working Safely in the Construction Industry

Course Aim

Participants will acquire knowledge of the following areas:

- Knowledge of applicable OHS legislative and safety requirements for construction work including duty of care;
- Knowledge of the range of common construction hazards and basic procedures for the assessment of risk and application of the hierarchy of control;
- Knowledge of OHS communication processes, information and documentation including the role of OHS committees and representatives, the meaning of common safety signs and symbols, and procedures for reporting hazards, incidents and injuries;
- Knowledge of general procedures for responding to incidents and emergencies including evacuation, first aid, fire safety equipment and personal protective equipment (PPE);

- Case study; and, practical exercises.

The assessment will require competent demonstration of all the 'knowledge areas' in this training course.
